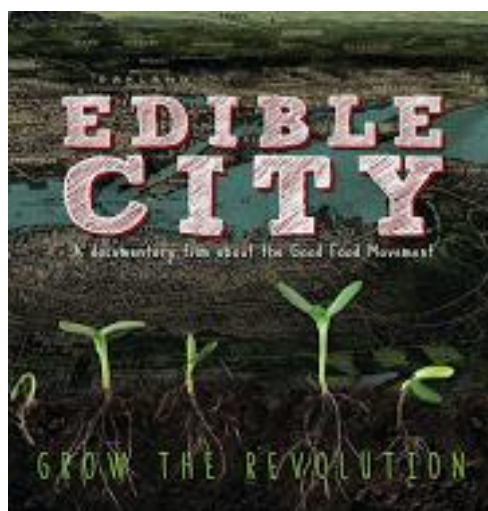
### Energy Group
