Transition Wilmslow is a grassroots community group with the aim of building a more 'Sustainable Wilmslow'. Transition Wilmslow is part of a world-wide network of local people committed to building sustainable communities via the Transition Network.

This Privacy Policy is designed to detail the basis on which Transition Wilmslow uses and collects personal information through the operation of our organization. It addresses the use of information provided directly to Transition Wilmslow by its members and interested

Each individual whose personal identifiable information is collected, recorded or used by Transition Wilmslow, has the right to know how that information will be stored, used and transferred and also has rights to access and control the use of that information (Data Protection Act 1998 and (from 25 May 2018) the General Data Protection Regulation. Personal identifiable information means any information on the basis of which an individual (the data subject) can be identified such as e.g. name, email address, phone number or the like. For more information on your rights of access, rectification and erasure of any personal data that we may hold about you, how to exercise these rights, and our contact details, please see section 7.

1. Information collected through contact forms and newsletter sign up

When you register with Transition Wilmslow, we collect your name and email address. We will use this information to provide you with updates on Transition Wilmslow projects, events and general news.

Please be aware that data transfer via the internet (e.g. when communicating via email) is subject to security risks. Therefore, complete protection against third-party access to transferred data cannot be ensured.

You may withdraw your consent at any time by choosing the unsubscribe option at the bottom of a Transition Wilmslow mailing that you have received.

We may disclose your personal information if we are required by law to do so.

2. Newsletter and organization updates

We use third party software and services to store our database of interested individuals and to send email communications. We track user activity to ensure we are sending relevant content and providing a positive user experience.

If you email us in a capacity that requires a response, or participate in a survey where you provide us with your email address, we will use your email address in a manner which fulfils

the required response or is in line with the specific terms and conditions specified by the so-called survey.

3. Storage and transfer of information to third parties

The third-party providers used by us will only collect, use and disclose your information to the extent necessary to allow them to perform the services they provide to us.

Particular providers that we currently use include Mailchimp, (a US based email marketing content provider), and Twitter and Facebook as providers of our social networking and marketing. Mailchimp processes some of our data activities such as the collection (e.g., via sign-up forms) and storage of personal data (e.g., within Transition Wilmslow's MailChimp account in order to allow us to create and use distribution lists, send marketing email campaigns) and the transfer of personal data to certain of MailChimp's sub-processors (who, as described in their Data Processing Agreement, perform some critical services, such as helping MailChimp prevent abuse and providing support to our customers).

Certain providers may be located in or have facilities that are located in a different jurisdiction than either you or us. So if you elect to proceed with a transaction that involves the services of a third-party service provider, then your information may become subject to the laws of the jurisdiction(s) in which that service provider or its facilities are located. However, regardless of a third-party provider's location, (from 25 May 2018) your personal data privacy shall still be protected by our obligation to comply with the General Data Protection Regulation, which applies to all EU citizens, regardless of where that data is stored or processed.
