

# Transition Wilmslow



Lindow Moss Community Forum Meeting Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> December 7.30 via Zoom

Transition Wilmslow established the Lindow Moss Community Forum in September this year, after surveying more than 400 local people over the summer. We heard how much the Moss is valued by the community of walkers, runners, cyclists and more who use it regularly, and hoped to give them a voice in how the Moss' restoration would be carried out. We have been told that this long-awaited restoration project is due to start next spring, but questions remain about many aspects of the works. For example, the proposed clearance of woodland in some areas of the Moss and the potential for active water level management via a sluice in the sugar brook.

At our second Forum meeting, at 7:30pm on Tuesday 8<sup>th</sup> December, we will introduce our community panel, discuss the progress with establishing a Liaison Committee, the results of a recent report on the levels and movement of water on the Moss and the current timetable for restoration. This will be complemented by a presentation about the ecology of Lindow Moss, and how it might change during restoration, from a local expert.
